

POPPING INSTRUCTIONS

- Turn Kettle Heat and Kettle Motor switch on.
- Make a test pop by putting 3 kernels of corn and 1 oz. (30 ml) of oil into the kettle. When the 3 kernels have popped, load the kettle with corn and oil charge.
- When corn has popped, dump the kettle.

CARE AND CLEANING

- 1. Each time you finish a series of popping, allow the kettle to cool down and wipe the outside of the kettle with a soft cloth to remove any oil drippings left behind
- After you finish popping for the day, allow the kettle to cool until it is not too hot
